Black Diamond Wedding Package

Pictorial Coverage of your special day by Principal Photographer

Timings, guides and information:

As the most important factor about photography is light, the best time of the day is late afternoon when the sun is low and the light has lost its harsh glare. Photography in the mid day sun can result in unsightly sweat beads, squinty eyes and harsh shadows accentuating facial features.

As a general rule, planning to start your ceremony about 2-3 hours before sunset will allow for good ambient light that is soft and flattering around sunset. This is also a generally cooler and more pleasant time for all concerned. Planning your wedding too late in the afternoon can be even worse! The premise of the day in terms of photography is to capture beautiful images of you and your partner in a relaxed and natural manner.

Generally the ceremony will go for between 30 and 60 minutes depending on Minister or Celebrant and location. The congratulations period between ceremony and family photos may take up to 20 minutes so try to be realistic about this time and allow for it on the day. I will not be pressuring you to hurry and will allow this period to be flexible and casual. Then generally comes family photos which may go for 15-25 minutes depending on the size of your family and number of guests.

Following this comes the bridal party photos. These are probably the most important photos of the day and I ask that we spend about an hour with you and the bridal party to allow maybe two or three different locations for the photography. These photos are often the emphasis of the day and are shot when the sun is low on the horizon and the temperature has dropped. We usually arrive back at the place of reception to enjoy the next part of the wedding after dusk.

All the above factors are static. They can vary depending on the weather or the type of wedding you are having. Many couples have asked me to shoot more candid photos rather than posed. Others have preferred to change the order of the shoot around entirely due to time restraints or location of the wedding etc....

Your wedding is your wedding and all of these factors depend on you. After meeting you on location and discussing what you want, I can draw up a tentative plan of the day. However flexibility and spontaneity can often lead to very memorable moments in your day which is yours to enjoy!



Photography Coverage:

Pre Wedding Ceremony:

This inclusive package covers the final stages of the Bride's preparation with photos at the Bride's house or hotel; along with the Bridal party preparation, Pre ceremony formal set-ups with bridesmaids (and Mum Dad if present) Then, the Groom and Groomsmen at the wedding venue prior to the brides arrival.

Discrete Ceremony coverage:

Guests arriving, the Brides arrival, Bridal party entrance, Brides entrance, followed by the ceremony, vows, ring exchanges and wedding certificate signings etc... POV angles of the church/room/location ceremony depicting the ambience of the event with celebrant, page boys and/or flower girls and guests, Post Ceremony Formals with family and friends from both sides. Then, Formal set-ups of Bride and Groom with and without bridal party at 2-3 locations dependent on organization, light and availability. This is full coverage of your wedding day so nothing will be missed

Reception:

Bride and Groom entrance into the wedding reception and introduced as Mr & Mrs for the first time General room shots, table and flower arrangements at the venue, cake cutting, and up to 2 hours into the reception including guests eating and having a good time, speeches, cake cutting and Bridal Waltz.

Please note Paul will need a seat at the reception as a guest

Delivery:

You will receive somewhere between 450-800 images (usually around 600 Images) within 3 weeks of your wedding day. Your Wedding Photography will be supplied on Wedding DVD Data disks x 6 copies. These images will have been digitally processed, colour corrected and edited. These images are scrupulously edited to ensure they bring out the best of you and your day to produce the finished product in both Colour and Black and White, then burnt to disk in both High resolution (for printing) along with Email resolution (ready to Email to family and friends) Along with a Wedding Album/Coffee table book. The books are available in three sizes (A5, A4 or A3) and in either square, portrait or landscape orientation for you to choose from along with a 5x7 photographic print of each image. Also, a PDF viewer of thumbnails on the disks is of all your images that can be printed out on any printer.

\$500.00 booking fee/deposit will secure your date then balance of \$2250.00 on delivery of your disks.

Extras:

Major Benefits **with this package include full coverage of the wedding as opposed to mock cake cutting and mock bridal waltz at the reception, all images at full resolution without the need to order prints afterwards and 5x7" print of each photo.** Your wedding images will also be archived in my studio filing system. If for any reason you may need another copy of the disk at any time, extra copies are available at \$25.00 per disk.
